WHEN CAN I START?

You can kick start your PGN journey as soon as you receive the welcome email.



WHEN & WHERE CAN I PLAY?

The PGN hosts 35 competitions per week at a range of home courses both North & South of the river. In addition to the daily competitions we offer 50+ special events and series fixtures as well as many PGN tours and trips.



BOOKINGS

All daily competition bookings will open at 5am - 14 days prior to the competition. All bookings are made through the PGN members portal. If these slots are full, please call the Pro Shop of that particular course to book a tee time then notify the PGN staff member of your booking. There is more information on the booking process later in the welcome pack.



POINTS SYSTEM FOR BOOKINGS

We use a points system for online bookings. \$1 = 1 point. Simply load up your account with points to use when booking daily competitions and special events. You can make, change & cancel bookings at any time. You also can book in other members using their points. More information around the points system is covered later. Points can be refunded at any time to the card from which the payment was made.

HOW DO I GET A HANDICAP?

You will need to play 3 x 18 hole rounds to get a handicap. You can use the MiScore App to log these rounds if they are at a PGN competition. Alternatively, they can be completed on physical cards at any course if played with a registered Golflink member. Please send all 3 completed handicap cards to info@perthgolfnetwork.com.au

Please fill out your card correctly and include the following:

- Player & marker names, date, player & marker signatures
- Marker G/L number, gross score on each hole, each nine & overall total





MISCORE APP

We use the MiScore App for all scoring in our competitions and events. Simply download the app to your phone & once you have created a MiScore account, select PGN as your home club (Login details are the same as your members account).

THE GOLF VOUCHER BOOK APP

Download the App from the 'App Store'. **Use the access code that is provided in your PGN members portal**. Find this under my information and then in the membership box "WA Golf Voucher Book Code:". This will allow you to log in to The Golf Voucher Book App. (NB, vouchers cannot be used for PGN comps and events). Save on green fees, carts, range balls, lessons & hospitality, 35 Perth courses, 100 vouchers, \$5k savings, across metro & regional courses.

A 15 round series, held 3 time a year, played on Saturdays and Sundays at courses all over Perth. A FEDEX style points system is used and the winner of each series gets the next season free.



MACIAS MATCH PLAY SERIES

Join the PGN Macias Match Play Series. Division A, B, C & D, knock-out format, monthly matches. Match Play is the purest form of golf.



PGN MASTERS BREAKFAST

Watch the final day of the Augusta Masters, enjoy a full cooked buffet breakfast and play Joondalup Resort when the Masters finishes.



THE LONGEST DAY - CANCER COUNCIL



4. Scroll down the list of competitions and select the course and date you wish to play. The Red Information button will provide you with details about the competition, course and any contact details you may require.



- 6. Guest bookings can be made at the bottom of the 'BOOK GROUP' page. Guests of PGN members with or without handicaps are welcome to play up to 5 times in a 12 month period before joining.
- 7. Complete booking using your points. A verification window will come up when the booking is completed and a confirmation email will be sent to your email.

POINTS SYSTEM FOR ONLINE BOOKINGS


PGN USES A POINT SYSTEM FOR ALL ONLINE BOOKINGS

The points-based booking system allows you to

- Easily change and cancel bookings for daily competitions & special events.
- Book fellow members in using their points.
- · Cancellations are immediately refunded to your points account.
- Less transactions and credit card re-entry
- Points can be transferred back to the account from which they were purchased at any time.



- 1. To add points to your account head over to your members portal, in the menu click on 'My Information' then in the 'My Points Account' window click the 'TOP UP POINTS' button.
- 2. Select an amount of points you would like to add to your account and complete the points top up on the payment page below:





3. You can check your points transactions at any time in the transaction history section:



4. To have any points refunded, email info@perthgolfnetwork.com.au with your name, membership number and amount of points you would like refunded. The points will then be transferred back onto the card in which you used to pay.



IMPORTANT BOOKING INFORMATION

BOOKING FEES

Daily Competitions: 10pts Comp Fee required at time of booking.

**Carramar & Marangaroo require full payment (Green and Comp Fee).

Special Events: Full payment is required at time of booking.

TEE SHEETS

Tee sheets will be open for bookings at 5am, 2 weeks prior to the date of the competition. Tee sheets will close 12 hours prior to your booking so we can inform the course of final numbers.

BOOKINGS OUTSIDE OF THE TEE SHEET

If the tee sheet is full, members can book tee times outside of those listed on the tee sheet. Provided there are 2 or more PGN players in that group. Please contact the course directly and make your booking with the Pro Shop and then let the PGN staff member who runs that comp know (staff list on the weekly newsletter).

REFUND POLICY

10 Points Comp Fee's:

- > 12hrs notice Full refund to PGN points balance.
- < 12hrs notice No refund.

Special Events & Green Fee's:

- > 48hrs notice Full refund to PGN points balance.
- < 48hrs notice Full refund to PGN points balance if the spot is filled.
 No refund if the spot is not filled within the 48 hour window to the event.


NO SHOW POLICY

It is vital that you cancel your booking to allow golf courses to fill your spot. It reflects poorly on you and all PGN members if you don't show up and don't let anyone know. If a member fails to notify us or the course of a cancellation the following will apply (based on a 12 month period).

- · 3rd No Show: 1st Warning
- · 5th No Show: 2nd Warning
- 7th No Show: 1 month handicap suspension with no access to PGN competitions or special events.

CANCELLATIONS

Just click the red X button in your allocated tee time to cancel any booking and your points will be returned to your account.



If you need to cancel your booking inside 12 hours for a daily competition or inside 48 hours for a special event then please head over to the 'BOOKING CANCELLATION & REFUND REQUEST' button in the members portal menu and complete the details required. Reminder you only need to complete this form if you are within the refund policy timeline explained above. Otherwise you may click the red X button in your allocated tee time and you will receive a full refund.



MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

PGN'S QUICK GUIDE TO ETIQUETTE

THE NUMBER 1 THING:



Golf is a game best shared, it provides a rare opportunity to suck in the fresh air and share some good times with friends old and new. Enjoy your golf and try to help others enjoy theirs. Remember life is short & golf is hard.

BE A GOOD PERSON



Introduce yourself on the 1st tee and try to remember your playing partners names.



Keep phone use to a minimum.

remember you are trying to get away from your busy life.



Know the rules. You are new to the game so make a big effort to know the basic rules.



Dress to impress. Be sure to wear golf attire and tuck your shirt in. Always remove your hat in the clubhouse.



Be aware of your pace of play. Slow play is a quick way to upset your playing partners. Be ready to go when it is your turn.



Don't let it get to you. Golf is the hardest game on the planet. Getting a tiny ball into a tiny hole 400m away in 4 shots is really really hard. Be kind to yourself and don't take it too seriously.



Thank your playing partners and offer to buy your scorer a drink after your round.



Be helpful & courteous. Always help out a playing partner. If you have time; help look for balls, rake bunkers, pick up provisional balls, give distances with your range finder, give a walker a lift in the cart if they are behind. You will enjoy the day more if your playing partners are having a good time too. Try to think about the whole field not just your 4 ball.

LOOKING AFTER THE COURSE

Golf courses are for all of us. There is nothing worse than landing in a divot on the fairway, a footprint in a bunker or having pitch marks all over your putting line. Look after the golf course and it will look after you.



PITCH MARKS If you hit the green, find the spot where the ball hit the green and repair it. (always push inwards not upwards with your repair tool or tee) If you see another it just takes 2 seconds, so fix that too.



IN THE BUNKERS **Take the rake into the bunker with you**. Enter the bunker from the lowest point. Cleanly rake the shot mark and all of your footprints. Position the rake inside the bunker with the handle pointing away from the green.



DIVOT MARKS **Always carry a sand bucket,** replace the turf and chop your divots inwards. Apply a light covering of sand to smooth the surface.



PGN'S QUICK GUIDE TO ETIQUETTE

A PLAYERS OATH:



All players are expected to play in the spirit of the game by:

- Acting with integrity: By following the rules, applying all penalties and being honest in all aspects of play.
- Showing consideration to others: By playing at a prompt pace, looking out for the safety of others, and not distracting the play of another player.
- Taking good care of the course: By replacing divots, smoothing bunkers, repairing ball-marks and not causing unnecessary damage to the course.

ON THE TEE



Try not to stand directly behind or alongside your playing partner when they are teeing off.



Keep movement & noise to a minimum.



Be ready to go when it is your turn.



If you are first to the tee get a distance reading & keep an eye on your playing partners shot.




Park your buggy away from the tee box.

ON THE GREEN

Don't stand on or over the line of a playing partners putt. (Always walk around).



Don't stand behind or in front of the line of a playing partner who is putting.



Grab the flag stick if you are first in. Keep an eye out for your playing partners clubs. If you see a club on the edge of the green grab it and return it to it's owner.

PGN'S QUICK GUIDE TO PACE OF PLAY



MISCORE - ROUND TIMER

You can keep an eye on your round time as you go in the Miscore app. Your round timer is on the top left of the score entry screen. If you look like you are falling behind, please make an effort to speed up.



BE AT THE FIRST TEE AT LEAST 10 MINS BEFORE YOUR TEE TIME

Make sure you have your glove, tee's, balls, your rangefinder is handy, mi score is set up with your playing partner and you are warmed up and ready to hit.

HOW TO PLAY READY GOLF



Don't wait for playing partners to play their shot. Head straight to your ball if safe to do so.



If you are on the fairway, help a playing partner look for their ball within the 3 minute time limit.



Think about how you are going to play your shot on your way to the ball.



Hit as soon as it is safe to do so. Don't wait if a player is ahead of you but not ready.



While others are hitting. - Get ready for your shot, pick your club, get your distance, think about how you are going to play.



Your pre-shot routine (including practice shots) should be no longer than 30 seconds.

ALL PGN HOME COURSES AIM FOR PLAYERS TO COMPLETE THEIR ROUND IN NO MORE THAN 4.5HRS

ON THE TEE



First to the tee should tee off



Let the shorter hitters in the group hit first



Mark your card after you tee off or before if you are last.



Watch your playing partners shots carefully



Be ready to move to your ball as soon as you can

ON THE GREEN



Read your putt while others are putting



Finish off close putts and leave the flag in for long putts



Grab the flag if you are the first ball into the hole



Putt as soon as you can, don't wait if a player is further away but not ready



Leave your clubs close to the next tee



If you have fallen behind, 2 players should putt out and head to the next tee



PGN'S QUICK GUIDE TO PACE OF PLAY

PACE OF PLAY IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY

Pace of play, rules and etiquette are the most important aspects of the game of golf. All PGN members should take the time to know the basics. We all need to take responsibility for our speed of play. Enjoy your golf, but make sure you allow others to enjoy theirs.



KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP IN FRONT

Please try to stay within half a hole of the group in front. Example: when you are getting to the tee box the group in front should be playing their shots on the fairway.



PRE-SHOT ROUTINE & TAKING THE SHOT

Try to get your pre-shot routine down to 30 odd seconds. Limit your practice swings to 1 or 2 at most. Practice your routine outside of competition rounds. Do the same for your putting routine. Practice the process - pick the line, have a practice putt and get the ball to the hole within 30 seconds.



PICK UP IF YOU CAN NO LONGER SCORE

Most of the PGN competitions are stableford. So if you cannot make a point with your next shot, just pick up your ball and move on to the next home.



THE LOW MARKER IS RESPONSIBLE

The player with the lowest handicap in each group is responsible for the speed of play. If someone asks you to speed up, don't take it badly. Ultimately if you slow the group up you are actually slowing up every player behind you for the rest of the day. Once time is lost it is lost forever!



ALWAYS ASK FOR A RULING IF YOU ARE NOT SURE

If you are in a sticky situation and not sure what to do, ask your playing partners for a ruling. If you are still unsure, play 2 balls and ask the pro shop for a ruling after your round.



ALL OUR HOME COURSES ENCOURAGE READY GOLF

"Ready golf" is a term used in stroke play, which indicates that players should play when they are ready to do so, rather than strictly following the procedure of "farthest from the hole should play first" in the Rules of Golf.



3 MINUTES TO FIND YOUR BALL

If you haven't found your ball within the allocated 3 minutes, head to the fairway and play 4 in line with where the ball is lost or finished. You will be playing your 4th shot from this position.



MOVE QUICKER IN A CART

When a group is using golf carts, the driver should drive the partner to their ball, let them get their clubs & instead of waiting on them to hit, drive to their own ball and get ready to hit themselves.



USE YOUR BRAIN TO PLAY SMART & SCORE BETTER

Play to the fattest part of the fairway, aim for the middle of the green, avoid trouble where you can, use your handicap to your advantage, play shots you know you can make. Don't be too hard on yourself and enjoy the fresh air and good company!
